

Garbage power plant with wind power



Overview

It is a fully-enclosed and ventilated organic waste processing and renewable power generation facility, capable of processing up to 90,000 tons per year of organic waste (250 tons-per-day) and generating roughly 1.6 MW of clean green renewable power.
