All questions (should) end with a question mark. This conveys to readers that the sentence (or fragment in this case) should be understood as a question. That's not necessarily clear

What is correct answer for the question "Do you have...?"

Here are some good answers to the question, "Do you have money?" Yes. Yes, I do. Yes, I have money. Yes, I have five dollars. As Ustanak points out, Yes, I do have money. is
